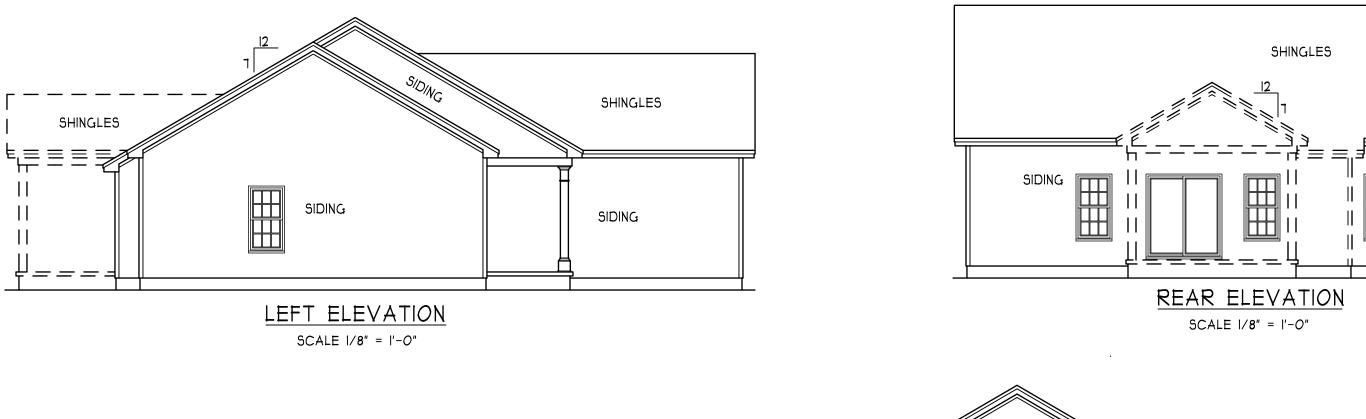

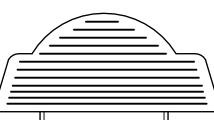


RIGHT ELEVATION

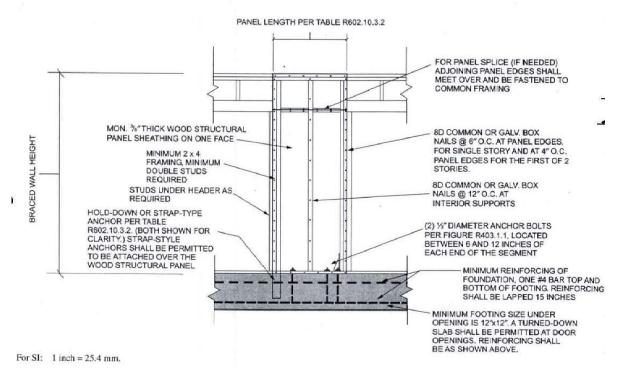


FIGURE R602 10.3.2 ALTERNATE BRACED WALL PANEL

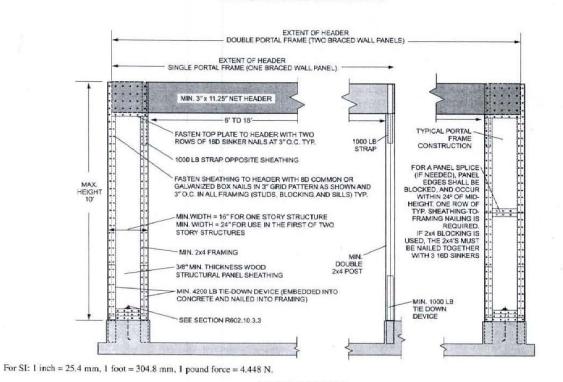

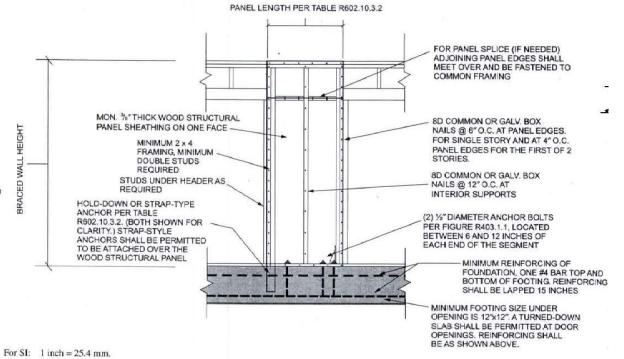


FIGURE R602.10.3.2 ALTERNATE BRACED WALL PANEL

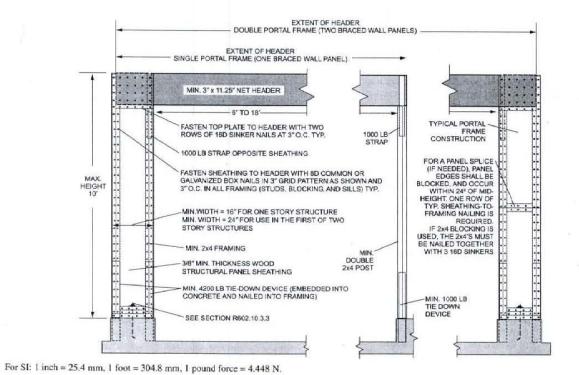
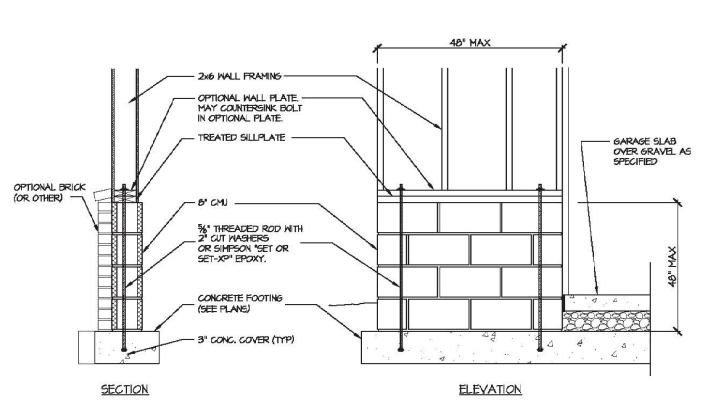


FIGURE R602.10.3.3 METHOD PFH: PORTAL FRAME WITH HOLD-DOWNS
